

KiDDOS Icons and Flags

The more complete list

These are the icons and symbols used throughout the KiDDOS application.

Orderset and Task Management are featured primarily at time of CPOE.

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KiDDOS Toolbar Icons



Previous Arrow Displays the chart of the previous patient selected in the Patient List. This icon is only highlighted if you have selected multiple patients, and if you are not presently viewing the first patient in the group.



Patient List Returns to the Patient List.



Next Arrow Displays the chart of the next patient selected in the Patient List. This icon is only highlighted if you have selected multiple patients, and if you are not presently viewing the last patient in the group.



Refresh Updates the patient list. Be sure to refresh often to ensure accurate information on your patient list.



Enter Orders Opens the Order Entry Worksheet to place orders on a patient.



Medication Reconciliation Medication Reconciliation facilitates continuity of the patients' home medication regimen between home and hospital use, between level of care changes during hospitalization, and between discharge and home use



RX Write: Create, maintain, and print patient prescriptions in an outpatient setting



Signature Manager: Sign and cosign orders, tasks, and documents.



Find Visit Opens the find visit window to search for patient visits by patient name, your role, provider, location, service, or visit status.



Find Patient Opens the Find Patient window, allowing you to search for patients.



Add Care Provider: Add yourself or someone else as a care provider for a selected patient.



Temporary Location Selecting this icon allows you to assign a temporary location for the patient or view a history of patient's locations.



Remove Patient Removes selected patients from the Patient List.



Task Viewer: View a history of task completion for multiple orders for the active patient.



Allergy Summary: Allows you to add Allergies or view active and inactive allergies of a patient.



View User Alerts: Allows you to view a history of the patient's alerts.



Worklist Manager: View a list of tasks to be performed for a patient or list of patients, and to indicate which tasks were completed within a particular time frame.



Enter Document: The icon takes you to the list of documents to enter patient information on various notes.



Flowsheet Manager: Create flowcharts to monitor, and review patient care clinical data via observation parameter rows on selected flowsheets



Expand/Contract: Displays or hides observation parameters on the Flowsheets tab, when the tab appears.



Report: Opens the Report Selection window, allowing you to print reports.



Clinical Desktop: Opens the link to Clinical Desktop



Touchworks: Opens the link to Touchworks



Lab Resource Library: Opens the link to the Lab Resource Library



E Report: Opens the link to E reports



TPN Calculator: Opens the link to the TPN calculator.



Nursing Webpage: Opens the link to the nursing webpage



Lexi-Comp: Opens the link to Lexi-Comp to view new drugs, etc.



Exit Door Logs you off Clinical Manager.

KiDDOS Patient List Flags

Flags are a visual indicator of activity on your patients.

These flags will be shown in different colors and shapes.

New Orders Column

- If your flags are turned on, a flag will appear in your Check Orders column when an order has been entered on that patient by someone other than you. Orders you enter will not create a flag.
- **Red** flags indicate there is at least one new STAT order.
- **Green** flags indicate there are new orders, not STAT.

New Results Column

- **Red** flags indicate at least one or more abnormal numeric results.
- **Green** flags indicate normal results.
- **Yellow** flags indicate results without ranges/results to define normal/abnormal ie blood type, micro results, some textual/numeric results ie anion gap.

To Sign Column

- **Red** flags indicate you have something to sign.
- **Green** flags indicate “someone else” has something to sign.

To Verify Column

- Some orders cannot be acted on until they are verified. Examples are:
 - Medical Students can enter orders, but the orders will have a Pending Verification status until they are verified by a provider. Once verified, the order will become active.
 - The Registered Dietician orders tube feedings as a Professional Recommendation. The order will not become Active until the provider signs it.

New Alerts Column

- **Red** flags indicate the patient has a new alert.












New Documents















- **Green** flags indicate there is a new document that has been entered for that patient.

KiDDOS Orderset Icons

The Display panel in the Orders tab displays the orders for the patient. How the orders appear is determined by the View Filter panel.

The following icons identify the types of orders:











Icon	Description
	Clinical path in the Requested by or Requested by Details views.
	Conditional order . The number of active activations appears after the condition text: <condition text> (Avail Activations = x) where x is the number of remaining activations. When the number of activations is unlimited, x = Unlimited.
	Discharge order
	View has been filtered .
	Standard order set . This icon is available only in the Requested by or Requested by Details views.
	Order set with an order set form . Icon is available only in the Requested by or Requested by Details Views.
	Hold Order
	Linked order set . Icon is available only in the Requested by or Requested by Details view.
	Linked order set with an order set form . Icon is available only in the Requested by or Requested by Details view.
	Suspended order
	Master repeat order . A status of "Active Master Order" is used to identify a Master repeat order. The status is updated to "Repeat Generation Finished" when all repeat occurrences have been generated. The status is updated to "Completed Master Order" when the last occurrence has been completed.














	Repeat occurrence of a master order.
	STAT order
	PRN order
	Order has been modified and has a history . The icon appears when a user uses modify function to make a change to one of the fields on the order form for any order that is not on hold or pending verify (does not include pending Rx verify).
	Order is a member of a linked orders set . Visible only in the By Department and By Department/Status views. A ToolTip appears if you hover over the icon with the mouse cursor.
	Order has not been verified by the Pharmacy.
	Alert on an order
	Incomplete document attached to an order.
	Complete document attached to an order.
	A review on the order is required.
	A review on the order is overdue.
	Parent order of an order series.
	Child order of an order series.
	Order is pending verification of a maintenance action (for example, suspend, discontinue). The icon appears with a description such as: "A <i><maintenance action></i> request is pending verification."

KiDDOS Task Manager Flags and Icons

The following icons are used to identify the various task statuses in Worklist Manager.

A ToolTip appears if you hover over the some of the icons with the mouse cursor.

Icon	Description
	Single task occurrence with pending status.
	Multiple pending task occurrences.
	Task for a conditional order. The order must be activated to generate the task occurrence.
STAT 	Tasks that have been generated from STAT orders. If the order generates multiple task occurrences, only the first task occurrence is marked as STAT.
	A comment has been entered for the task occurrence. Comments can be added to future or past task occurrences.
	Task has been Marked as Done and then edited.
	A black check mark indicates that the task occurrence has been performed.
	A blue check mark indicates that the task has been completed automatically because the order status has changed to a status indicating it has been completed or performed. The task may also have been automatically completed by flowsheet documentation.
	Task has been Marked as Not Done. The reason for not administering the task occurrence can be seen in the Document Details.
	Task needs to be rescheduled. The task has been configured to prompt user to reschedule if the latest task occurrence has been Marked as Done later than the scheduled time.

	Task's scheduled times need to be reviewed because the patient has been transferred to a location that uses a different schedule for the order frequency.
	Task has been canceled because the order has been canceled, discontinued, or suspended. Suspended tasks also display the Suspend icon on the task description. Description is also crossed out.
	Task needs to be signed. It was Marked as Done by Other.
	Task has been suspended. The Task Description is appears canceled (crossed out). To unsuspend the task the order must be Unsuspended.
  	Task has an associated alert. High priority alerts are indicated with a red exclamation point; medium and low priority alerts are indicated with a yellow exclamation point. After the alert is acknowledged, the alert exclamation mark is black. If a task occurrence has one or more alerts, the exclamation point appears on an icon in the cell. If the task occurrence spans more than one cell, the first cell displays the icon.
	Task is being processed. This icon is removed when the processing is complete, or when Worklist Manager is refreshed.
	Task has not been verified by pharmacy.
	Task has a comment attached.
	Task is for an order entered within a linked orders set.
	A partial dose has been administered to the patient.
	An dose greater than what was ordered has been administered to the patient.
